Rules The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the racing rules of sailing.

Classes Classes will be determined By the race committee. If a PHRF boat does not have a rating certificate then the race committee will assign a rating [with no penalty]. Dinghys, small multihulls, and scows will race as one design. It is possible that these fleets may race using Portsmouth Yardstick ratings.
