Notice of Race

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of International Melges 24 Class Association, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to all Melges 24s as defined by their Class Rules. Competitors must meet all ownership, class membership requirements, and must have paid all event fees before becoming official competitors.

Entries: Eligible boats may be entered by completing registration with the organizing authority and payment of the entry fee. The entry form must be received along with the fee before racing commences on May 17, 2006. Please contact John Schumacher at 231-740-8088 regarding late registrations. Entry fee is \$175.00 which includes regatta fee and four tickets for Saturday's Dinner, payable to Muskegon Yacht Club.

Schedule:

Friday May 16

0800 - 2200 hrs Launching

1500 - 2000 hrs Registration and fluid replacement seminar part one.

Saturday May 17

0800 - 0930 hrs Launching, Registration

1000 hrs Competitor Meeting

1130 hrs Warning Race 1 with other races to follow.

Fluid replacement seminar part two immediately following racing.

Sunday May 18

1030 hrs First race warning with other races to follow.

Fluid replacement seminar part three immediately following racing.

Sailing Instructions: Will be available at registration.

Courses: Racing will be on windward/leeward courses as specified by the Sailing Instructions. Course length will be based on sailing conditions. Racing will be on the waters of Muskegon Lake. Muskegon Yacht Club is located at 3198 Edgewater Street on the Southwest side of Muskegon Lake. The Yacht Club phone number is 231-755-1414.

Penalty System: The 360 degree Turn Penalty, (RRS 44.2) will apply.

Scoring: The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A4, will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Six (6) or more races are scheduled, of which one (1) race shall be completed to constitute a series.

Awards: Trophies will be given to the top 5 finishers in each class with crew prizes for the top three.

Slips: Boats may be dry sailed or secured beam-to on the intermediate docks at Muskegon Yacht Club. MYC slips are for MYC members but a few are usually available for rent. If your boat ends up in a slip you will be billed for it. It is important to discuss your storage needs with John Schumacher at the e-mail or phone numbers at the top of this document.
