

#### MYC JUNIOR RACE TEAM PLACES 4<sup>TH</sup> AT GULL LAKE REGATTA!

At the end of Race Camp, the MYC Junior Race Team packed up lots of boats on lots of trailers and traveled to Gull Lake for the first West Michigan Youth Sailing Association regatta of 2016.



Amidst the 75 boats racing at this regatta, MYC placed 4<sup>th</sup> overall as a team out of 8 clubs competing, just 4 points behind 3<sup>rd</sup> place Macatawa Bay. This is especially exciting because several MYC sailors experienced racing for the very first time at this event.



In addition to being the 4<sup>th</sup> place team overall, MYC was the highest scoring team in the Laser Radial fleet and also the highest scoring team in the Laser Full Rig fleet.





