COMMODORE'S COMMENTS:

The Holiday Season is upon us and the Muskegon Yacht Club is a busy place. Holiday parties, Slip assignment meetings, and the normal hustle and bustle of the Holidays mean that Christmas and New Years are right around the corner. If you are looking for Christmas present ideas, Muskegon Yacht Club logo gear makes for an outstanding gift for your favorite sailor! We keep a limited supply in stock at the club but Kim can get you a custom order and even have items personalized for you in a jiffy!

If you have not done so already, please make sure to participate in our staff appreciation Christmas fund. We have a great staff and your contributions is an important way to say Thank You for the all the hard work and outstanding services that they have provided this past year. Return the slip that was in your billing statement or call or email Sue at the office. Your generosity is greatly appreciated.

We recently conducted a proxy vote to amend some of the MYC bylaws and the changes were overwhelmingly supported (over 85% for) however, we only received 116 proxies from our 274 voting members. As such and because of some confusion that some members had with the process, the board has determined to not proceed with the changes and we will be starting the bylaw amendment process over again. I would urge all of to promptly return your proxies when they are mailed. Our current bylaw procedures require us to conduct these via US mail and to provide stamped return envelopes for the proxy return. Between postage, printing, and labor, the cost of conducting a proxy vote is substantial and having to re-vote is especially painful for a finance guy like me. We will start with a special membership meeting to discuss and will proceed with a vote shortly thereafter. Keep your eyes open for the notices as this process commences in a few weeks.

As we move forward into 2017 the board will be considering what projects to tackle next. Recently a circumstance arose that really brought this into focus as we were asked by the family of a recently passed life member to suggest a

memorial gift that would have a lasting impact on the membership and it forced us think about the future a bit harder.

Fortunately, we did not need to start from scratch as the Strategic Planning Committee is continually working on setting and implement goals for the future of MYC but, it did make us think about formalizing a wish list and I thought it would be good to share it with the membership. The order is more in terms of magnitude not priority and the dollar amounts are very rough estimates. Nor is this list all-inclusive but it is a start and it makes for an interesting exercise.

- Rebuild/Replace our Junior Sailing Facility the Octagon building is
 not in great shape, leaks like a sieve, and as such is in need of
 significant investment. So much so in fact that replacement may be a
 more fiscally responsible course of action than repair \$100-150k (or a
 new roof at the very least \$30K)
- Refurbish and redesign the club entranceway including the addition of an elevator to access the Lakeview room, and second floor restrooms \$100-200K
- Refurbish the pool bathhouse baths and adding a sundeck above \$75k
- Installation of the approved pier on the north and South end of the marina \$50k
- Architectural fencing to enclose the property \$30-50k
- Redesign and replace covered patio and canopy \$10-15k

And of course we have major maintenance items that will need to be addressed some sooner rather than later:

- Replace leaking and failing windows on the "lake" side of the building.
 \$20-30K
- Repaving the parking lot \$30k

The above list is approximately \$400k! and will clearly not happen overnight but the old joke applies. How do you eat an elephant? One bite at a time. It starts with a vision and goals. We are blessed with an amazing location here on the shores of Muskegon Lake. Our charge is to enhance and maintain our facilities to a high standard in order best serve our membership.

To conclude this month's message, I would like to take this opportunity to wish Merry Christmas, Happy Hanukah, Happy Holidays, and Happy New Year to the entire MYC family. May the blessing of the season be upon you all, and may Santa bring you a nice lightweight present from the sail loft.
