COMMODORE'S COMMENTS:

Greetings and welcome to the midpoint of the offseason! The Boat Show in Grand Rapids is this month and in only four to six weeks people will start working on their boats in earnest and in only 12 short weeks, boats will be launching to begin the sailing season! (How's that for optimism!)

The club reopened January 25th after a short annual closing for deep cleaning and repairs. Several things have been upgraded and a deep clean of the facility was undertaken. The women's restroom received a makeover (so I am told) and some new furniture was put in place so that we can better enjoy the fireplace during these cold winter months. The staff put in many hours of back breaking work to accomplish this in just 16 days. The carpet is literally hand scrubbed on hands and knees to get the yearlong accumulation of stains and grime removed. This is not a "simple and quick" cleaning but a deep power scrub. The board was witness to the stark "before and after" line at our monthly board meeting and it was striking. We looked into having a service do the deep clean of the kitchen this year to save time but the bid for the work we do was over eight thousand dollars! So the staff stepped up and completely disassembled the kitchen removed all the equipment cleaned every nook and cranny. These annual efforts have been well rewarded by the outstanding ratings we are now consistently getting from the health department on our regular kitchen inspections. Our staff is amazingly dedicated to MYC and I thank them all for the outstanding work that they do.

Of course you can't please everybody. Like any organization you always have your chronic complainers. We have compressed the time we close down to only ten operational days. Given the scope of the work undertaken this is rather remarkable given our limited staff. It is unfortunate, and more than a little pathetic, that a few shortsighted individuals feel it necessary to complain and belittle the effort.

Andy Bos and his D&Y crew are hard at work putting the finishing touches on the rest of our new pool fencing and gates that should be in place for the pool opening. We have a Safety at Sea seminar coming up May 6-7 (see the web site for details). Our new Trans Michigan Race from Milwaukee to Muskegon on June 23rd, as well as our racing season kicking off the first week of May. It is going to be a busy year!

We are in the middle of the budgeting process for our 2017-2018 fiscal year and we are prioritizing projects and objectives. Last year we tackled some much needed painting and repair projects (Octagon Building, bath house bathrooms), a new makeup air system to get our kitchen air handling up to code, and air conditioning in the Spinnaker room. This year we are looking at the windows on the east wall of the lounge and the round room which are leaking and causing deterioration of the substructure of the wall. It is an old building and it is important to maintain it for not only present usage but for the generations to follow. Improvements to our Junior's dock may also be on the agenda, and replacement of the patio awning is also on the wish list. Of course the roof on the Octagon Building is also looming as a project for this year or next.

The Super Bowl, March Madness, hockey, a new Beer tasting dinner to add to our very popular Wine Dinners. Lots going on at the club during the winter months so please don't wait until spring to pay MYC a visit. Chef Adam and his crew are putting out outstanding meals (I had the short ribs last Saturday and they were amazing).

We are fortunate that the club is doing well financially. Our membership continues to grow and our sales continue to increase. MYC continues to be an outstanding value for its members and is one of the few Yacht clubs on the great lakes to remain open year round. We operationally lose money during the winter months, January and February in particular but, we remain open to serve our members. Take advantage of this and stop by for a meal or cocktail.


