COMMODORE'S COMMENTS:

Greetings!

The Club had a successful and productive Launch Day, the Grand Reopening of the MYC Pool, our first Wed night races, a fun Commodores Race, and the traditional Memorial Day weekend Parade of Commodores (led by a bag piper of course). A VERY busy month of May!

We also in May completed the By-Law amendment vote with all three proposals being adopted by significant margins. The most significant of these changes was the creation of a new membership class. The new Junior Membership is open to new Members who are age 35 or younger. The dues structure for the Junior Membership will be finalized at this month's board meeting but it is anticipated that the Junior Membership dues will be approximately 50% of the Full Membership Dues. These Junior Members would automatically become Full Members in the year they turn 36. We already have several people who have inquired about this new membership level and coupled with another existing bylaw provision, my daughter and sonin-law will likely be one of our first Junior Members. Children of Full Members who are under the age of 30 can join MYC without paying any initiation fee. I would encourage all of you with young adult children in the area to seriously look at the new Junior Membership. It would make a great Christmas gift to get them started!

June is already upon us and with the cold and wet spring it sure doesn't feel much like June but, the calendar keeps rolling along. The Torresen and BBS Spring regattas are this coming weekend and we are fast approaching the Tripp Memorial Race (starting in Holland this year on June 21st) and our inaugural Trans Michigan Race from Milwaukee to Muskegon on June 23rd. Entries are flowing in for our new Trans Michigan Race and we are busily preparing for the event.

We will need some volunteer assistance for the Trans Michigan event so please let us know if you are willing. There will be an organization meeting announcement coming soon (if it hasn't gone out already). We will need to shuttle people to the Lake Express terminal, docking assistants, greeters, check in assistance, t-shirt sales, and more. This is OUR event and to date, most of the entries are out of town boats so we want to put our best face forward and be an outstanding host. We feel this event can grow to be 75- 100 boats strong if run a great event. We are creating a "New" Tradition with the Trans Michigan Race, one that we hope will establish a long legacy. A beautiful custom permanent trophy is being commissioned as well as very cool and useful take home awards. It is also not too late to enter so let's make this event a great one.

We have also just finalized the date for the Second Annual Commodores Ball. This year it will be on Saturday August 5th starting with cocktails and hors d'oeuvres on our beautiful new pool deck, followed by gourmet fare from Chef Adam and live music to dance the night away. Seating will be limited so be sure to sign up quickly when the announcement comes!

I would like to address our ongoing saga of our dock repairs. HOPEFULLY they will be completed in the coming week with the installation of the permanent ramps. To say that we are disappointed with the extended delays from our contractor would be an understatement. Please know we are pushing hard for completion and I am on them every day.

Finally, I would once again like to thank ALL the many people who devote countless hours of their time, significant talent, boundless generosity to the Muskegon Yacht Club. The place simply could not function without you and your efforts. We would need to contract and staff at a much higher level which would in turn require significantly higher dues if it were not for the considerable and significant efforts of our volunteers.

This month I would again like to highlight our D&Y and Pool Chairman Andy Bos, Steve Johnson, Past Commodores Mike Stewart and Jack Andree for their significant contributions to the transformation of the Muskegon Yacht Club pool. If you haven't seen it, it is spectacular and we could simply not have done it without the contributions of time, talent, and treasure that they provided. It is now complete except for the top rail which we are still exploring options for. Thank you!


