#### **COMMODORE'S COMMENTS:**

Here it is the first of August already! With the Chicago to Mac Race, Little Traverse YC Ugotta Regatta, and lots of boat transport, the month of July goes very quickly for me. As most of you probably heard, the Mac race was a pretty brutal slog with a 24 hour stretch of 25+knots out of the north with big, steep waves. EVERYTHING on the boat was wet and I heard noises I have never heard from my boat before. Then of course it went very light for the next 20 hours and a third of the boats entered did not make it to the island this year. The race had further drama with lots of damaged boats, damaged people, a capsize, and a Man Over Board that our own Bill Newman and the crew of Aftershock played a critical role in. A member of the Aftershock crew spotted the MOB which greatly facilitated, what can only be called a miraculous recovery. When I heard the radio call my heart sank because I knew in the violent conditions that a positive outcome was highly unlikely. The lessons of our recently held Safety at Sea Seminar were played out in real life that night.

Congrats to all members who participated in the race and especially to those that FINISHED! It was a tough one and will go down as one of the most memorable.

MYC had a busy month with normal goings on and several large private events. The pool has been very busy in the hot weather, and the Juniors have been out in force! We have FINALLY seen some progress on the gangway installation (with a new contractor) and the heavy rains have further raised the Muskegon Lake water levels which has flooded some of our docks on the sea wall. We have moved quickly to raise the docks and four of the nine were completed as of last night, with hopefully the rest done today. Obviously, this is a situation beyond our control and raising the docks is not a simple, quick, nor inexpensive thing to do. I greatly appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we work through this.

We are truly blessed with an amazing staff at MYC who do a great job in occasionally very trying circumstances. Things don't always go smoothly and things happen, opinions differ. The professionalism and efficiency that our staff displays always but especially when things don't go as planned, is

something we should all be proud of. Most of the time you won't ever even know, and that is how it should be. Our GM Kim, Facilities Manager Nicky, Business Manager Sue, Chef Adam and their staffs really do an outstanding job. As Commodore part of my job is staying out of their way and let them do their jobs. The experience and institutional knowledge that they have is amazing. There is not much they haven't seen or considered when it comes to MYC.

It is the time of year that we must start thinking about next year. Board elections, Committees, budgeting and strategic planning will all be kicking into gear again all too soon. I would like to ask each of you to step up and be involved in the club. Join a committee, agree to be on the board, participate! Yes, it is a time commitment and yes, we are all busy but, the impact you can make in making MYC a better place is important and very rewarding. More to the point, MYC needs you to be involved.
