Greetings Members,

This edition of the Portwatch includes information on a proposed Bylaw amendment. I did not participate in drafting the amendment, but I think it proposes an important and useful change to how we elect our Board. A membership meeting to discuss the proposal is scheduled for Saturday, August 3, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.

The primary focus of the amendment is to allow annual elections to be held via secure electronic voting. I think this is an important and allaround "good idea" because our current election system typically generates a voter turnout of less than 10%.

Last year's annual meeting is a good example of why our must-bepresent-to-vote system is frankly, a complete failure. Our annual elections are held on a Friday night in October at 7:30pm. For a host of reasons, including many out-of-town members and October high school/college sporting events, attendance at our annual meetings is to be kind—sparse.

At the 2018 annual meeting, we had a runoff election for a general board member position. We had approximately 230 voting members eligible to vote at that time. Keeping in mind that our Board has eleven members and boat owners receive two votes per membership, you are hopefully both disappointed and surprised to learn that the total number of votes cast between the two candidates was less than 40. Without counting heads and running a bunch of statistics to help you understand how poorly attended this meeting was, I think it is enough to say that we typically end a sparsely attended annual meeting and go downstairs to a standing-room-only bar. This is good for business, but ultimately bad for our organization. It has been this way for as long as I have been on the Board.

I've been on the boards of many organizations. A common thread among the successful ones is being committed to making it as easy as possible for people to participate in the organization. The proposed Bylaw amendment is a good step in that direction.

Special Membership meeting to discuss proposed By-Law Amendment

Greetings,

The necessary signatures have been obtained and the Board of Directors has set a special membership meeting on Saturday, August 3, 2019 at 10 am to discuss the following proposed by-law amendment.

The purpose of the amendment is to:

 allow electronic voting for our elections so that more of our members can participate in the election of our board of directors. Currently, you must attend the annual meeting to participate which means that in reality, only a very small percentage of our eligible voting members participate in the process. While our current procedures were fine when the club was founded and virtually all the membership lived nearby, currently nearly 70% of our voting members do not live in Muskegon. This amendment involves significant changes to Article IV & VI of the bylaws and relatively minor changes to Article VII. It was developed in conjunction, and with significant input from the By-law committee.

 clean up some language about when our annual and semiannual meetings take place. The current language is tied to launch and haul out day which we no longer have.

As the changes are interrelated it is necessary to approve or reject this change as a package. The purpose of the meeting is to collect input, discuss pro's and con's (which will be summarized and published), and if appropriate to amend the language as a result of the input from the meeting.



Dick Rodseth Elected to LMSRF Hall of Fame 1931 to 2001

MYC Member 1985 to 2001

Richard Rodseth "Captain Dick" will be inducted into the Lake Michigan Sail Racing Federation (LMSRF) Hall of Fame on Saturday, July 27th, at the Muskegon Yacht Club.

All MYC members are welcome to be at the award presentation and visit with the Rodseth family and Vagary crew on

the 27th at 4:00 PM, with a celebration toast and tall tales to follow until 5:30 PM. Gene McCarty from LMSRF will be here to perform the ceremony.

Capitan Dick has one of the most impressive sail racing records on Lake Michigan (see back pages of Portwatch). In 1982, Dick launched Vagary, a Petersen 43. A bare hull and deck was completely built-out based on Dick's design and Dick's labor. Dick relocated the boat from Chicago to West Michigan in the fall of 1983 and became a member of MYC shortly thereafter.

Dick was a "Master Mariner" sailing in 51 Chicago – Mackinac races and participated in every major race on Lake Michigan. People were drawn to Dick. He always included everyone and always invited everyone, especially newcomers to get involved in the sport of sail racing. Dick introduced many young sailors the sport, five of which are current members of MYC. He was always willing to help out fellow sailors with advice, gear or loaning tools to do the job. Besides being very helpful and outgoing, he was also a very gracious loser, being one of the first to congratulate a competitor who had beaten them in a race. Dick had a true passion for the sport.

We hope you can join us.
