
As previously mention this past fall, the recommendation from Edgewater Resources and MYC's Outer Dock Committee, it was felt our best option for the club is to utilize the assets we have with our attenuator sections at this time. We have been clear at the start of the offseason, that we felt this was going to be an important year to turn the page and move forward with the next step of that process. We are planning to remove section 2 (out of the 5 sections) in the early spring and replace it with a container. Once the damaged section (see pic) is out of the water we will be able to assess the damage and get an accurate estimate on the repair. There is no way of knowing or getting an accurate cost estimate until it's out of the water. Hopefully, the estimate will be reasonable and we will be able to reuse and relaunch this section putting in place of the current container (section 3) that has been out there in use for a year and a half. As mentioned above, early spring is the timeframe we are shooting for in this process. To get the ball rolling this winter we are working on having a beefed-up 45' container built that will be ascetically better looking and with more flotation than the one currently in use. When the project is completed, all 5 of the sections will be disconnected from each other, anchored and swinging on their own, thus not beating themselves up in storms and proving protection for our marina. Insurance proceeds from the previous storm damage to the attenuator have been saved and available to cover the costs for this needed project.



Additionally, in November we had two 13" diameter plying's (see pic) installed at the end of the finger piers of slips 5 & 6 and 8 & 9 on "A"

dock to help take some of the pressure off "A" dock during east wind blows.


