Dock and Yard Committee Report:

April was a busy month for Dock and Yard as we worked with volunteers to prepare for outdoor activities on the patio and the docks. Many volunteers gathered over two separate weekends to complete several spring projects. Docks (which were in dire need of cleaning) were power washed, rockers underwent some needed repairs and painting, the patio canvas awning was repaired by Lakeside Canvas before being installed.

Thank you to all the volunteers when complete the long list.

To help preserve the wooden rockers Dock and Yard requests that rockers move to the grass be moved back to the concrete after use. The moisture in the grass is contributing to their demise.

Thank you to Kim McDaniel and her volunteer team for their hard work caring for the gardens. Over two separate weekends they managed the grasses by splitting and removing followed by spreading many wheel barrows of mulch around the club house.





Several of the on-going and planned projects include completing the renovation to the showers, repair of the back-flow preventer so water can be turned on at the docks, and lowering of the raised wooden platform on the fixed dock.

As a reminder to all slip holders attachments to docks must be pre-approved by Dock and Yard. Also, please use dock lines that are sized appropriately for your boat. The weekend of June 25th and 26th MYC will be hosting the finish of the Queen's Cup race. Dock and Yard is anticipating a very full marina with boats moored, rafted, and docked in as many places as possible. Dock and Yard requesting feedback from slip holders who will be traveling that weekend or who are willing to move their boat to a mooring ball so that we can accommodate as many racers as possible.

As of the writing of this submission, MYC has 26 boats registered for the 2021 racing season. This number will grow. The club marks are in place, now numbered rather than lettered (a request by the USCG) MYC has a new RC boat and has refined the NOR and SI's to assure even better racing for all. The Section breaks are being finalized and we will be racing Wednesday night, May 5th. YES, THIS WEDNESDAY NIGHT

Wednesday night sailing is just the start of things for the summer of 2021. The Blacklock Cup is back in full force, and will be awarded to the boat with the best finishes in the Commodore's Cup, May 30th, the Nedeau Cup, July 3rd, the GRSC's Commodore's Cup August 14th and the Governor's Cup, September 4-5.

MYC will also host its annual stronghold events such as the Midwest One Design, May 15-16 and the Clipper Cup, August 6th. These events are foundational events for MYC and are growing in popularity thanks to strong committee involvement and leadership.

New for 2021, MYC will host the 2021 C-Scow Nationals, June 18-20, the Queen's Cup finish, June 26th, the WETA Nationals September 9-12 and a second Midwest One Design regatta, October 16-17. Each of the events should allow MYC to showcase our club, our race-track and all that we enjoy at MYC.

MYC is on the rise as a destination for sailors to compete and hold their class regattas. These new 2021 events are a result of continued and focused work by the RRC, and this will continue. MYC Swim Lesson Levels

Level 1-Introduction to Water Skills (Age 2-3years)

Objective: To help students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the

water safely

Requirements: None

Skills Covered: Entering and exiting the water safely, learning to submerge mouth, nose and eyes and breath control, front and back float and recovering to a stand, changing direction in the water, swimming 5 feet on front and back.

Level 2-Fundamental Aquatic Skills (3-4years)

Objective: To give students success with fundamental skills

Requirements: Students entering this level must possess a Level 1 certificate

or demonstrate all the Level 1 skills

Skills Covered: Entering water by stepping or jumping in from the side, submerging entire head, blowing bubbles, open eyes underwater, front and back glide, swim 15 feet on front and 10 feet on back, swim on side, life jacket use

Level 3-Stroke Development(4-6Years)

Objective: To build on skills in Level 2 through additional guided practice **Requirements:** Students entering this level must possess a Level 2 certificate or demonstrate all the Level 2 skills

Skills Covered: Jump into deep water, head first entry from sitting or kneeling, submerging and retrieving an object, bobbing, survival float for 30 seconds, treading water for 30 seconds, front crawl 15 yards, butterfly 15 feet, back crawl 15 yards, elementary rescues, safe diving, check-call-care

Level 4-Stroke Improvement (5-7years)

Objective: To develop confidence in the strokes learned thus far and to improve other aquatic skills by increasing endurance through swimming greater distances

Requirements: Students entering this level must possess a Level 3 certificate or demonstrate all the Level 3 skills

Skills Covered: diving, underwater swimming, feet-first surface dive, 1 minute

of survival floating, treading and back floating, 25 yards of front crawl, breaststroke and back crawl, 15 yards of butterfly and elementary backstroke and sidestroke, compact jump from height in a lifejacket, throwing assists and caring for conscious choking victim

Level 5-Stroke Refinement (6-10years)

Objective: Coordination and refinement of strokes

Requirements: Students entering this level must possess a Level 4 certificate

or demonstrate all the Level 4 skills

Skills Covered: Shallow dive, tuck and pike surface dives, 2 minutes of survival floating, back float and treading water, flip turns on front and back, 50 yards front and back crawl, 25 yards butterfly, breaststroke, elementary backstroke and sidestroke, 2 minutes of survival swimming, rescue breathing

Level 6-Swimming and Skill Proficiency (10-up)

Objective: Refine strokes so students swim them with more ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances; includes "menu options" - Personal Water Safety, Fitness Swimmer and Fundamentals of Diving

Requirements: Students entering this level must possess a Level 5 certificate or demonstrate all the Level 5 skills

Skills Covered: 500 yards continuous swim using 100 yards each of front & back crawl, 50 yards each of breastroke, elementary backstroke, sidestroke & butterfly and 100 yards choice of any of those strokes, survival floating and back floating 5 minutes each, feet first surface dive & retrieve an object from 7 feet, Cooper 12-minute swim test.

Race schedule permitting, the Past Commodores will line up in the parking lot at 2:45pm based upon year of service. The Parade of Commodores will begin at 3:00pm, led by a bagpiper, to the flagpole. A brief ceremony will take place followed by the blessing of the fleet and flag ceremony.

Due to the ongoing unpredictability of the COVID situation there will be no pot-luck luncheon but we will have other options available. Also, due to indoor capacity restrictions, if inclimate weather is predicted the parade event may be canceled with short notice. We apologize for the inconvenience of these issues but would like to try to have an event this year.
