

# Special Membership meeting to discuss proposed By-Law Amendment

## 6:00 pm (EDT) Thursday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Greetings,

At the May 14, 2021 semi-annual meeting, the Board of Directors voted unanimously in favor of the following proposed by-law amendment.

A special membership meeting has been set for <u>Thursday,</u> <u>July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 6:00 PM</u> to discuss the proposed amendment.

The purpose of the amendment is to:

 allow electronic voting for our elections so that more of our members can participate in the election of our board of directors. Currently, you must attend the annual meeting to participate which means that in reality, only a very small percentage of our eligible voting members participate in the process. While our current procedures were fine when the club was founded and virtually all the membership lived nearby, currently 43% of our voting members do not live in Muskegon. This amendment involves significant changes to Article IV & VI of the bylaws and relatively minor changes to Article VII. It was developed in conjunction, and with significant input from the By-law committee.

 clean up some language about when our annual and semiannual meetings take place. The current language is tied to launch and haul out day which we no longer have.

As the changes are interrelated it is necessary to approve or reject this change as a package. The purpose of the meeting is to collect input, discuss pros and cons (which will be summarized and published), and if appropriate to amend the language as a result of the input from the meeting.


