#### 2022 Slip Assignment Information

#### RSVP Required. MYC Slip Assignment Meeting Dec 4, 2021, at 1pm

IMPORTANT: Please be sure to read this entire email as it contains important information about this year's slip assignment meeting – as well as instructions for how to attend the meeting.

This year's slip assignment meeting will take place in-person at the yacht club and with an option to attend remotely via computer or phone.

#### The following must attend the meeting:

- Existing slip holders who wish to consider moving to a different, available slip.
- Members currently on the slip waiting list.
- Members who are not on the slip waiting list but who wish to request a slip in the MYC marina.

It should be noted that members who had a temporary slip for 2021 are not guaranteed a slip for 2022 and will need to request a new slip for 2022.

#### All slip transfers and assignments will be made in the following order:

- Existing slip holders who want to transfer into a different slip will be addressed on the basis of seniority & slip availability.
- Open slips and dry-sail spaces will be filled according to seniority on the Slip and Dry-Sail Area waiting list.
- If after a complete review of the Slip and Dry-Sail Area waiting list, slips remain open, members at the meeting, but not on the waiting list may request a slip.
- The Dock and Yard committee retains the right to award slips based on boat length and slip size.

All members who plan to attend the slip assignment meeting are requested to send an email to jeff.blum213@gmail.com indicating their intent to attend and if attendance will be in-person, remotely, or by a representative.

Instructions for attending the meeting remotely appear below at the bottom of this email. If, for a legitimate technical reason, you cannot attend the meeting via the internet or phone please indicate this in your email.

- Members attending the meeting virtually via computer will be able to see a visual map of the marina to help them select an available slip.
- Remote participants may request via email an aerial photograph of the marina indicating currently available slips. This will be provided Saturday morning prior to the meeting. Please print or have this photograph readily available when your opportunity to request a slip arises.

We have some ideas to improve the award presentation format for next year. We were a bit rushed this year from the short window to plan and implement, so the overall awards presentation will be slowed down some for 2022.

Our Race Calendar for 2022 is almost complete and will be published before the New Year. It should be noted that MYC is not hosting any major adult regattas in 2022. This is a result of the COVID shutdowns of 2020. The RRC was not actively soliciting any large Nationals Regattas or events in 2020, due to the fact that everything was shut down. 




