

Dock and Yard Committee Report:


Did you know:

- The Dock and Yard committee is responsible for the operation and maintenance of everything outside of the clubhouse.
- Most of the maintenance is performed by volunteers.
- To control spending contractors are hired for specific skill set projects that are beyond volunteers' expertise.
- The list of projects around the clubhouse and marina is big.

If you are interested in taking on a project and helping reduce the list of things that need to be completed, please contact Dock and Yard.

April consisted of a full schedule of volunteer projects to prepare the marina for boats and the clubhouse for outdoor living.





Last of the platform removal

Work included removal of the raised wood platform from the top of the fixed dock, removal and power washing the deicers, setting out lawn and pool furniture, power washing the fixed dock, and repairs to the steel structure at the east end of the fixed dock. I am sure that there are a few unmentioned but I think you get the idea.

The upcoming list of projects includes (to name a few):

- Install the patio awning;
- Install the pool awning;
- Install deck boards to the east end of the fixed dock;

- Replace the deck boards on the west end of the fixed dock;
- Complete power washing of sections of the fixed dock and angle attenuator;
- Paint the new container that will be installed as a wave attenuator.

More projects than a single weekend of volunteers can complete.

As you make your way out to the outer "B" dock you will notice the poor condition that the surface of the fixed dock is in, and the eastern portion has 2x12's for deck boards. This is a temporary fix so that members can access "b" dock safely. Parts are currently being fabricated to hold the grey plastic deck boards in place.

And now you ask... **what's up** with Tucker Marine, the ugly barge and crane, and the mess of a wave attenuator we have? I can happily report that progress is being made in between the rain and wind:

- The week of April 18th Tucker continued working on the floating container fabrication which is going to be installed in place of the half-submerged yellow container in the wave attenuator line-up.
- The week of April 25th Tucker completed installation of three (3)
 new piling to help support the outer "B" dock and installed the new
 piling hoop at the end of slip 1 which was damaged in the 2021
 spring eastern wind event.

Starting the week of May 2nd Tucker will move the barge outside of the attenuator to begin moving and re-anchoring the attenuator sections. Following this they will be removing the yellow half-submerged container and replacing with the new container after fabrication is completed.

Tucker also plans to add additional anchors to the attenuator sections to add weight to help prevent movement from ice in the future.

Weather permitting, we anticipate the attenuator work being completed in June.







In June the MYC Book Club will move to meeting on the second Thursday evening of the month at 6:00pm. June's read is The Castaways by Elin Hildebrand.






