
I can't wait to see you all out on the lawn and on the water soon. March 1st means it is T-minus 64 days until our first race of the season!

Greetings fellow MYC members!

We are in the process of finalizing our 2023-2024 fiscal year budget and I want to thank my fellow Board members and Committee members, as well as our General Manager Kim and especially Sue Peters for the hard work that goes into this arduous annual process.

We held a budget meeting on February 11th and with our ambitious goals to pay down the remaining balance of our debt over the next five years this year was even more challenging than in years past. We are looking at every budget line to make sure we are managing all of our expenses closely. One of the budget expense lines that continues to grow is the fee we pay when people use credit cards to pay MYC. Depending on the card and the method that it is used we are hit with a 3.75-4.5% fee when people pay us with their credit card. Ten years ago, this did not amount to a lot of money so other than occasionally exploring different clearing companies for better deals we simply absorbed this fee as a cost of doing business. As times have changed and we have become a more cashless society, this amount has grown significantly to a point that we feel it must be addressed. We are currently on track to spend nearly **\$20,000** in credit card fees in the current 2022-2023 fiscal year.

Given this sizable expense the budget committee recommended to the board of directors and the board of directors has approved that starting May 1st, 2023, credit card charges at MYC will automatically have a 3% service charge added. In surveying our peer group, we have found that this is common in virtually all private clubs and is increasingly common in many, especially small businesses, and even our State and Federal Government.

It is important to understand that MYC is a not-for-profit entity and we budget and price things to a breakeven point. We do not have significant profit margins to continue to absorb this increasing expense. Increasing prices to cover the fee is not fair to the people who do not pay by credit card as they end up subsidizing the fee for those who do pay with credit cards.

We will be offering options for people to automatically pay their MYC account charges, dues, slip fees, etc. via ACH payments direct from your bank accounts, in order to avoid the 3% fee. Other options are to use your banks bill paying services which will issue and mail MYC a check at no charge to you at all, (even for postage). Of course, you can still write a check or pay cash, or use a credit card and you will be charged the 3% fee starting May 1st 2023. You will be receiving more correspondence directly on these options in the coming weeks.

The good news is that the club continues to operate on sound financial footing. The budget process is challenging especially when faced with the challenges of mother nature's ebbs and flows. The changing water levels that just a two short years ago were threatening to flood us, have now subsided to the point we are likely to be dredging the harbor. Both extremes cause expenses to the club. Maintaining our aging structures is an ongoing labor of love. We are also faced with an extremely challenging labor market and the inflation of cost of goods and services that we are all currently seeing in our daily lives.

Your GM Kim, has done an outstanding job keeping our staff with us and controlling cost in a difficult environment. Sue of course continues to keep us organized, and informed of our ongoing financial status as well as on budget. The board of directors spends much time and energy to keep the club on track and moving forward. We strive to provide an outstanding experience for all our members by providing great staff, Services, and facilities to meet our membership needs. Not surprisingly our marina is full and our membership is at near record levels. I am looking forward to another season at MYC.






Blacklock Cup Trophy Scoring:

As spring nears, Dock & Yard has a big list of "To-Do's" that need to be completed before the marina fills up. Help will be needed with the following from many volunteers.

- Power washing the docks.
- Reconstruction of the finger slip between slips 70 and 71.
- Repair broken deck boards.
- Reconstruct the east end of the fixed dock to replace the wood planks with deck boards.
- Dock cleats need checked and bolts tightened.
- Bringing out lawn furniture, etc. from winter storage.
- And more!

As the time D&Y intends to have work-bee's scheduled for every weekend in April so stay tuned for notices.

Other projects that D&Y is working to complete this spring include repair to the concrete block seawall along the juniors launch area; replacement of the broken and settled concrete in the southeast corner of the Melges area parking lot, replacement of the concrete and carpeting at the main clubhouse entrance, and the facia repair on the southeast corner of the clubhouse.

Also keep note that the 84th Queen's Cup Regatta is finishing at MYC on July 1st. D&Y is anticipating a very full marina with competitor boats moored, rafted, and docked in as many places as possible. Dock and Yard will be requesting feedback from slip holders who will be traveling that weekend or who are willing to move their boat to a mooring ball so that we can accommodate as many racers as possible.


March 18 Join us for Rock Painting


