



The concrete repair in the southeast corner of the property is near complete. SK Environmental and Kloote Concrete was on-site Tuesday May 2nd to being demolition followed by pouring the concrete the next day.





The next concrete project will be to replace the concrete at the front door. This is anticipated to start Wednesday May 10th. The entrance carpet has been removed and the concrete will be replaced with Stamped concrete.

On Thursday, May 4th Versatile Roofing began the work to replace the roof membrane on the Octagon Building. This work is anticipated to take a week to two weeks.





You may have noticed a piece of construction equipment sitting on the beach. No, this is not a new play structure for kids. Soon T.R. Ghezzi Marine will be performing repairs to the stacked concrete blocks near the Junior beach launch. This should be wrapped up by Memorial Day.

On the weekend of June 30th and July 1st MYC will be hosting the finish of the Queen's Cup race. Dock and Yard is anticipating a very full marina with boats moored, rafted, and docked in as many places as possible. Ice sales are now available! Our new ice chest from Home City Ice was delivered and stocked for the start of the 2023 season. The new chest is now located by the Melges drysail area. Home City Ice purchased Arctic Glacier at the end of the 2022 season and will now be our vendor going

forward. Unfortunately, Home City (the only local ice company now) does not produce block ice at this time. Therefore, we will only be selling 7# bags of cubed ice for the 2023 season. We will continue to search for block ice suppliers, though it is not looking promising.

How to purchase ice at MYC: Due to the new location of the ice chest, bartenders will no longer retrieve a bag for you.

Option #1 - Please let the bartender know how many bags you are going to take from the ice chest and they will add it to your tab.

Option #2 - Self serve via the member charge sales sheet located on the ice chest door. Please clearly write your name (first and last) and how many bags you are taking.

Option #3 - Non club members / reciprocal members must pay with cash or card at the bar, no exceptions.

For your convenience, we will leave the ice chest unlocked for afterhours ice sales. We rely on the honor system to ensure all ice is properly accounted for.

As part of a new Portwatch series, I am going to interview all our living Past Commodores to learn more about this great club and how it has changed and thrived all these years. My first interview was on May 3 with Past Commodore Wesley Anderson.

Wes Anderson joined MYC in 1950 and was elected Commodore in 1970. Mr. Anderson took his position very seriously and worked through many issues during his time. He said, "I had a responsibility to the membership when I took office." Wes immediately began working on a formal budget for MYC. He met with a CPA and went line by line on expenses and income. He created a budget, forwarded the budget to the appropriate committees, and held them responsible for such. At that time, the bar offered 25¢ draft beers which was not profitable, and he wanted to change that. He stated they had to get creative on starting some events, such as the Lobster Dinner, as nobody liked the idea of increasing dues at that time – He tried, and it was "shot down."

Wes had regular meetings with committee chairs and head personnel to make sure they had an outline of their responsibilities, how to carry them out, and how to report back on their progress. He once took a week-long vacation from his paying job to paint the entire outside of the building. He started with a group of guys and completed the project solo a few days later.

Wes also worked very hard in helping to create and maintain organized racing at MYC with most of our competition coming from Spring Lake Yacht Club and White Lake Yacht Club. At that time, we had seventeen International 210's racing at MYC. He is proud of our yacht club races and hopes the Muskegon Yacht Club name will stay alive with more races and regattas, especially across Lake Michigan. Wes had a fleet of his own with a 210, a butterfly, a twelve-foot' powerboat and a twelve-foot' rowboat.

As our time together was closing, I asked Wes, "What advice would you give to the membership?" He stated, "Get involved in a committee – find out what's going on within the club." I also asked Wes if he would have done anything different during his time as Commodore. He answered, "I would have run the kitchen as a professional kitchen, which it was not at that time." He said, "I would have given them more room to work as it is tough to execute a great dinner or event in such a small space."

He then added a small snippet to say he was very, very thankful, and grateful for the wonderful event that we hosted in honor of his 90th birthday in 2021. He loved showing off the club, especially to his Country Club friends, and raved about the food buffet that was prepared for him.

I want to thank Past Commodore Wes Anderson for taking the time to speak with me. I thoroughly enjoyed speaking with him and getting the inside scoop about MYC in 1970.




