

moved forward with the pledge, checklist, and certification process. On Memorial Day, I met with the Clean Marina inspector at MYC for our on-



Simply fill out the customized payment form and submit! Your payment will be transferred directly from your bank account to MYC's bank account. There is no cost to you.

ACH stands for Automated Clearing House, a U.S. financial network used for electronic payments and money transfers. Also known as "Direct Payments," ACH payments are a way to transfer money from one bank account to another without using paper checks, credit card networks, wire transfers, or cash.

This service is available to us from ChoiceOne Bank and is powered by Autobooks...both are Michigan companies.

Each month, you will find the link and QR code on your monthly statements, and on the MYC website (on the home page under "Quick Links"). Of course, we will continue to accept all other forms of payment (cash, checks, debit cards, Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover.) Our previously announced 3% surcharge on credit card transactions has not begun yet, but is coming soon and will be announced.

This month I was able to sit and talk with Past Commodore Andy Price.

Past Commodore Price was approximately 12 years old when he first started coming around MYC. Andy's parents joined MYC so he could take sailing lessons. He and his friends, Josh Wallace & Adam Schiller, would ride their bikes to MYC for sailing lessons. Afterwards they would fish and swim then ride their bikes home in the evening. This was a typical summer for them until Andy moved off to college. Once Andy graduated college, he found himself back at MYC where he became a member in 2004 then Commodore in 2015.

Past Commodore Price shared with me numerous memories from his time at MYC. The first memory he shared was of how proud he was to be on the Board during the conception and vote of the Capital Improvement Fund. He stated it was a "pivotal moment for the health of the club." He was quite ecstatic when the motion passed. The second memory he shared was more of a funny one.... It was a 70's themed party inside the clubhouse where there was music, dancing, and Jay Wallace Jr.'s ridiculous mustache. He still has a picture of that night and laughs each time he looks at it.

Club operations ran smoothly during his time as Commodore. He noted there were no staff turnovers which made his year "smooth sailing." However, Andy had a mission in 2015 and it was to increase the taps on the draft beer tower from 4 to 6 choices. With hard work, donations, and fundraising, he was able to complete that mission.

Andy has owned a variety of boats from pontoons, to a 38' Sea Ray, a turbo charged Melges 30 (Peerless), and a Soto 40 (Arma) throughout his life (so far). Andy won the Trans Michigan Race with Peerless in 2017 then again with Arma a year later in 2018. He also won several other local races such as the Commodores Cup in 2018 (Arma) and the GRSC/ MYC Commodores Invitational 2020 (Arma). Andy sold his race boat not so long ago as it was no longer a fit for his growing family.

A snippet of an article written about Past Commodore Price in 2018 from Past Commodore Bud Ainsworth I thought was worth mentioning: "I would also like this month to acknowledge and express our heartfelt gratitude from MYC to Andy Price and his crew on Arma, Nic Siefert, Mike Gassmann, Dave Fox, Mark Regan, Jay Wallace, Chris Eggert, and Magnus Clarke for their selfless sacrifice during the recent Chicago Mackinac race. A couple of hours after the start of the race, Arma blew out its mainsail dashing their hopes of a podium finish on the new boat. Having to return to Chicago, they came upon the scene of an ongoing search of a missing sailor who had fallen overboard, just an hour earlier, and his life vest had not inflated. Sea state conditions were extremely rough with waves 6' to 8' high and winds 20 to 25 mph. Andy and his crew spent close to 4 hours helping search for what would be like searching for a needle in a haystack. Although the missing sailor was not found, the crew of Arma are truly heroes for trying."

As our time came to an end, I asked Andy "What advice would you give to our membership?" He replied, "You get out of the club what you put in it." The more involved he got throughout his years at MYC the more he understood the work that people put in. "Our club is only as strong as its members."

Thank you to Past Commodore Price for his time today. It was fun to hear your stories about MYC and to see how much things have changed throughout the years.



Another Excerpt from our Sailing School Handbook


How do boats float? How do you explain this to a beginner youth sailor? Our average age of our student is between 8 and 11 years old.
