Reminder:

New applications for first time membership ONLY on or after July 1 of any calendar year shall be accompanied by a payment based on a month prorated basis plus the entire initiation fee. The prorated amount will be equal to 1/12 of annual appliable membership dues multiplied by the number of remaining months at the time of the application.



STARTING TODAY - credit card transactions at MYC will automatically have a 3% service charge added to offset the cost of payment card processing. **This change was first announced several months ago and it is ready to implement**.

If you wish to avoid the extra 3% when paying at the bar, you may pay with cash, check or MYC charge account.

Likewise, if you wish to avoid the extra 3% when paying your MYC charge account bill (house charges, dues, slip fees, etc.) you may:

- pay with cash at the bar
- mail a check
- use your bank's online bill paying services (usually no cost to you)
- pay online via ACH payment direct from your bank account at no cost using <u>THIS FORM</u> (available on the MYC website or by scanning the QR code on your statement)

MYC still accepts Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover cards with a 3% service charge now added on.

November 22nd—Bar Olympics. Spend the biggest bar night of the year at MYC. More details to come.


November 25th—Michigan/Ohio State football game. Cheer on the home team!






