

Happy 2024 and may the new year find your sails open!

Have you ever wondered what happens while your Club is closed in January? Here are some of the things that our staff will be working on:

- The kitchen goes through a complete tear down and deep cleaning. Every piece of equipment is meticulously cleaned, and any necessary repairs are made. This makes it possible to keep the kitchen clean throughout the rest of the year. You may not know it, but our Club consistently receives a "clean bill of health" from the Muskegon County Health Department, with zero infractions. When the Health Department makes their surprise visits, we are always ready.
- This includes moving every plate, dish, pot, pan, and piece of flatware, as well as prep tables, coolers, and racks out of the kitchen so that nothing is overlooked. These items are all cleaned as they are moved back into the kitchen into their storage places.
- The restrooms are cleaned thoroughly. This includes maintenance to the fans and drains.
- The Lakeview and Spinnaker Rooms are deep-cleaned and reorganized.
- The bar, bar coolers, and bar walk-in cooler are all taken apart and painstakingly cleaned, as well as the back room. Usually, the ice machine is also cleaned, and maintenance performed to keep it running "just one more year." This year, however, we were able to finally purchase a new ice machine that will make and store more ice per day at a lower cost. It uses much less water and is air-cooled. It is being installed during this shutdown.
- The Bar, Round Room, and Lakeview Room chairs, stools, and tables are all cleaned and polished. Our wooden chairs have lasted for decades, thanks to Nicky and the fact that she checks

every single chair and performs routine maintenance on them during this time. She also re-stains them as needed.

- Our staff will be participating in a test kitchen with our food supplier and a new menu will be in place when we reopen.
- And finally, all the carpets will be professionally cleaned. After that, our staff will move everything back where it belongs and you will never know all this has taken place, except for the clean, fresh smell you will notice when you walk in the front door at 4:00 pm on Friday, February 2.

The next House Committee meeting will be Saturday, February 10, at 10:00 am, and is open to all members.

I hope that you all will have a wonderful January "See ya at the Club!"


